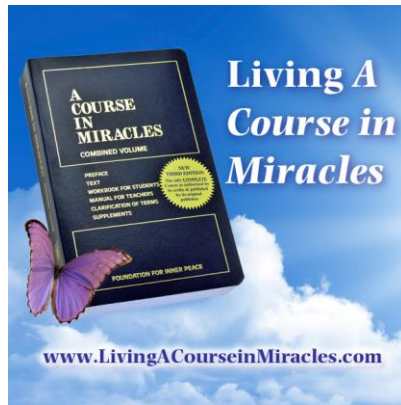

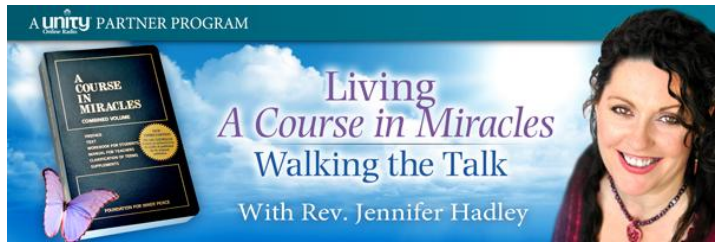

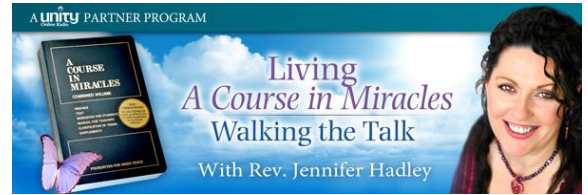

Get ready to focus on your intent to be the Love, be the Peace through practical application.

Here is your host, Reverend Jennifer Hadley.

Jennifer Oh, bonjour! Bonjour, bonjour. I am so happy to be with you, so grateful, so thankful. I am back in the USA now in California temporarily, traveling right around the world. If you go from when I started in Hawaii, left Hawaii beginning of April to go to the *A Course in Miracles* conference in Las Vegas. I definitely have gone around the world. I flew in from Australia yesterday. I was just sharing with Jeff, my engineer, I left Australia around noon on Monday and I arrived in Los Angeles around 9 a.m. I arrived before I left. Crossed the international dateline.

Yes. When I went from Germany to Australia, I lost an entire day, because of travelling across so many time zones. But I have to say my time in Australia, which was pretty much the last week, was just exceptional. The Australian people are fantastic. We had such a good time together. I did four workshops and a Sunday sermon. It was spectacular, spectacular people. I got to meet so many beautiful Spirits. I'm so glad that I said, "Yes," to follow my guidance in going to Australia. Well worth the effort, hmm, to meet so many wonderful people who are interested in walking the talk and living the Love right along with us.

Let's jump into with a blessing and a prayer here today. Yes. Our topic is about Finding Our Fundamental Goodness, discovering, remembering that Truth about our life in our being, is that we are fundamentally good.

Yes! I'm Jennifer Hadley and I love to pray. We're finding our fundamental goodness moving right into our heart which is the essence of our fundamental goodness.

Opening Prayer

So grateful and so thankful to open ourselves to a healing prayer, a powerful inspiring prayer. So grateful and so thankful to allow ourselves to recognize and remember that our true nature, our true identity is already as Holy as Holy can be. We can't become any more perfect than we already are.

So grateful and so thankful to surrender the habits of playing small and living in lack, attack, limitation and separation.

So grateful to open ourselves to remembrance of our true identity which I the Mighty I AM Presence, the I AM that I AM. The Holy Spirit is our true nature. The Christ is our true selves. We are the Holy Son of God. We are the perfect Christ already.

We're willing to remember the Truth that sets us free from all belief in lack and limitation. We are grateful and thankful to share the benefits of our healing, conversation with everyone because we're One with them.

In gratitude, we allow the healing to be. In gratitude, we know that it is done, and so it is. Amen. Amen, Amen, Amen.

Truth: The Nature of Our Being

Indeed. Yes, indeed. Uh-hmm. Yes. Alright. Well, let's jump right into it here. Spirit guided me to Chapter 1, Section 6, which is *The Illusion of Needs*. Doesn't it seem like we have many, many needs? The section right before that is *Wholeness in Spirit*. It says right towards the end of that, its section actually *Wholeness in Spirit*, it says in Paragraph 5 of that section.

"Whatever is true is eternal, and cannot change or be changed."

That's the nature of us. This is for us to remember. Whatever is true is eternal. We are the Truth. So that's why the Truth sets us free. The Truth is what we are, is who we are, and is the very nature of our life and being.

Now, where we go astray and start causing our suffering is when we start thinking that there's something wrong with us that we're not who we

really are. Doesn't it make sense that if we start denying our true identity, which is whole, perfect and complete, and start believing that we're something else, that there is something wrong with us, that we're bad, that we don't have what it takes, that we should be punished, or someone else should be punished, someone else is wrong or bad, that we can easily be let astray and start thinking all kinds of things are wrong and bad, and that's where the needs erupt from. The needs erupt from our thinking that we're not who we really are. When we remember who we really are, all needs are met in God, in our true identity.

But when we start thinking that we're not perfect whole and complete, then we start to have needs. That's where all needs arrive from. Whatever is true is eternal, cannot change or be changed. That's how we know was the difference between belief and the Truth. Truth is eternally true and beliefs are false. They are not eternally true. They are the story that we made up, the meaning we made of it. They are our interpretation. That's what beliefs are. Truth is true. We don't have individual versions of the Truth, though sometimes we like to claim that.

My Truth is, we say, my Truth is, what is true for anyone is true for everyone because we're all One, so how could we have a different versions of the Truth. That doesn't make any sense. I find this particularly comforting.

One of the things I did last evening, I arrived and staying with friends. We've watched the presidential debates, Hillary Clinton and Donald Trump debating. I went on Facebook a little bit afterwards and saw people sharing their opinions and thoughts about it. For some people, I totally get that it's frightening. It's frightening that this candidate or that candidate could be the president.

I remember at the last presidential election, I had two people who were in my classes coming to me and one saying, "If this candidate wins, then life will be hell and it's going to be a horrible future for our children. If Obama wins, the future of our children is at risk. I'm really frightened for that. If the other candidate wins, then it's a horrible future for everyone."

Two students, both studying *A Course in Miracles*, both with the same exact set of values, pretty much each one supporting a different candidate, and thinking that that candidate represents Truth, Beauty, Wisdom, wholeness,

Freedom and the all good of God and the other candidate represents a nightmare.

We've got the same thing happening now that—it always happens at presidential elections, doesn't it? That one candidate represents a hellish future and the other candidate represents the best possible—well, maybe not the best possible, but a better choice. We can get very tense, very nervous, very triggered, very frightened because of our beliefs. It's only the Truth that's going to set us free. Whatever true is true is eternal and cannot change or be changed.

Aligning with Divine Will

"Spirit is therefore unalterable because it is already perfect, but the mind can elect what it chooses to serve. The only limit put on its choice is that it cannot serve two masters. If it elects to do so, the mind can become the medium by which Spirit creates along the line of its own creation."

If we elect to do so, our mind can become the medium like—medium is also another—you could think of soil as a medium. If we elect, our mind can become the medium or the soil by which Spirit creates or plants its thoughts along the line of its own creation. So, we can elect that.

We can elect to have our mind be used for God's creation rather than—as *A Course in Miracles* talks about making things in this world. We can be the creative substance of God's eternal creativity, creating only like itself pure perfection.

This actually is where we can use our freewill to align with Divine Will. Remember, one of the things that *A Course in Miracles* talks about is, there is only Divine Will. There is only God's Will. There is no separate will, but we can align with Divine Will, or within our experience in the illusion, we can seem to choose or elect to choose separation. We can choose unification or separation. We can use our mind choosing infinite creativity, Beauty, Truth, Wisdom. So the way that we can best serve God is to give our mind over to the thoughts we think with God which are the thoughts that are true.

It says a little bit later on this. It's my Page 13. We're at the end of Chapter 1, Section V, *Wholeness and Spirit*. In Paragraph 6, it says,

"The Miracles assigned at the mind has chosen to be led by me in Christ's service."

Remember the miracles when we have a shift in consciousness and when we have a shift in consciousness to the thought system of the Christ, that's a miracle. When we experience the miracle in form, it's the demonstration of the shift in our thinking. What we would call a miracle is usually a shift in form, when something miraculous happens, but we can live a miraculous life all the time.

The Spirit is Our Guidance

I'll give you—Spirit's giving this little example of something that happened to me when I was in Australia. Australia has a different electrical system. America has—I don't what it is. We have different voltage systems. America has one kind of a plug. The UK has another kind of plug. Europe has another kind of plug and Australia has another kind of plug. You cannot plug American plugs into UK or European or Australian plugs. You have to have adaptors. Three different adaptors. There are companies that make universal adaptors that work for all four different systems. There may be even a fifth system that I don't know about. Don't know what they're doing in Russia or Japan or places like that.

I'm going to take a sip of my tea here. Cheers. Excuse me.

I didn't research what kind of a system they had on Australia. I presumed that probably Australia was either on the UK system or the European system. I didn't think that they would have their own system. I just didn't think that they would, but they did.

When I got to Australia, first in Cairns in the northern part which was so nice, my host, they had an adaptor for me to use that was great. I thought, well, the people I'm going to be staying with in Melbourne are more likely to have an adaptor. I thought, I asked Spirit, "Should I get an adaptor when I'm at the airport?" And I got, "No, you'll be fine." Okay, so I trusted that as I've learned to do.

When I got to Melbourne, it was late at night. The stores were closed. I realized, "Oh, I don't have any charge left in my laptop and I need to send my blog, and this and that. Do you have an adaptor?" My host said, "Oh, no. we don't have an adaptor." They said, "We have one for Britain. We

have one for Europe, but we don't have one for Americans." I thought, "Hmm." They say, "Well, you can use my laptop," but everything that I've written, my blog and all those things were on my laptop, but I'd ran the battery down on the airplane. There was no charge left. I thought, "Well, okay, I guess I will have to write a new blog and figure out a way to record it, the prayer, et cetera, and let's just start again."

Then, a minute or two later, my host comes in and says, "I just bought this the other day and it was like a power pack kind of a thing that had USB ports and it had universal ports in it to plug anything in." I said, "That's it! I can use that. That's perfect."

Just a lesson is Spirit had guided me, "You'll be fine." When I got the news, "Oh, no, we can't help you. You're going to have to write your blog again. Tomorrow, we can go to the store and get you an adaptor, but not tonight. The stores are all closed." I just went, "Hmm." My gut feeling was, of course, this has to be for the highest good. Even though it seems like, initially, it's late at night. I'm tired. I've been traveling and I don't really feel like writing another blog. I've learned. Because sometimes I'll write a whole blog and send it off, and the e-mail just disappears, it goes erased. My staff will say, "Well, we never got it." "Are you kidding? I sent it." "It's not in my outbox and it's not in my sent mail." It just disappears. That happens from time to time. I think, "Oh, okay. I guess that wasn't today's blog." I guess I'm supposed to write another one. That was just a warm up. Warm up spiritual espresso, it's time for a second shot.

I've learned that that's the way to go. Just go with it, flow with it. The Spirit's not tricking me. Nothing bad has happened. Nothing wrong has happened. I was prepared. Okay, I guess I'll write another blog. It's one of the days. I'll use the one I wrote tomorrow if that feels right, we'll see.

Because I didn't get upset or irritated or afraid because I've learned that everything works together for my good. There are no exceptions. That's my practice. Then within two minutes or less, here comes the perfect universal charger for me, adaptor thing. Perfect. What did my host tell me? "I just bought this the other day." She bought it around the time that I was queering the spirit. "Will I need to have an adaptor for my next stop?" "Nope, got you covered." I was a little surprised when we didn't initially—she didn't have anything, but then I know it had to be for my good, rewrite the blog, do something different. Go with the flow.

This is what I have found is, believe it or not, we're constantly unhooking the decisions that we made about life. I could have gotten triggered into a decision that I would've gotten triggered into years ago where life does not support me. All of my needs are not met, the illusion of needs that I am not fundamentally good, therefore life does not support me, and I have this illusion of needs.

Finding Peace Through Forgiveness

It says in *The Illusion of Need* Section, which is Section VI of Chapter 1, in Paragraph 1. Again, we're on my Page 13. It says,

"You who want Peace can find it only by complete forgiveness."

What is forgiveness? Forgiveness is having no judgment. When I found out, oh, initially, there's no adaptor. You're going to have to rewrite the blog. Yes, it's late at night. You'll have to start all over again. I didn't judge it as being wrong or bad or not supportive of me, just "Uh-oh. Okay. I guess I will do that then." This somehow is working together for my good. Trusting that, having faith in that, then I was not upset. There was no annoyance. There was no thought that I was betrayed by Spirit because Spirit had clearly said to me, "No, you don't need to buy an adaptor." I could buy an adaptor, but I didn't need to buy one. I would be provided for. I was following my guidance.

Even though the momentary appearance was that I had misinterpreted the guidance, that something was wrong, I didn't allow myself to interpret it that way. I just looked to, "Oh it must mean I'm to start again and write a new spiritual espresso and use that one tomorrow."

"You who want Peace can find it only by complete forgiveness."

I didn't interpret the situation. I didn't make a meaning of it that I wasn't supported. I wasn't loved. I was being punished or something was bad. I didn't go into interpretation. I just started looking for the good.

It says, *"No learning is acquired by anyone unless he wants to learn it."*

In that moment, I was looking to learn how this could be for my highest and best. How can it be? I don't know. Let's find out. Let's learn. No learning is acquired by anyone unless he wants to learn it and believes in some way that he needs it. Trusting that everything was working together for my good, there was going to be some learning that would be valuable to me.

It says, "While lack does not exist in the creation of God, it is very apparent in what you have made."

We make our interpretation. We make our meaning of things. This is where we move out of creation, perfect creation, perfect Love. We can stay in that perfect Love, in that perfect expression of Divine Wisdom, or we can change our mind and go into lack and limitation. Yes. While lack does not exist in the creation of God, it is very apparent in what you have made.

"It is, in fact, the essential difference between them," between creativity and making things.

We're going to talk more about lack, Abundance, Prosperity, and we're leading towards our fundamental goodness. All of this, we're going to continue on the second half of our show here.

The Spiritual Qualities of God

Hey there, everybody, welcome back. I just want to mention something. Last week's broadcast, there's some kind of technical difficulty related to uploading the file to the podcast service, so we're going to reload the second half of the show somehow—I don't know. I did something technically. We've got the second half of the show. You're going to have to delete it from your podcast in order to get the second half of last week's show which—I can't remember what it was called right this second, but it would've been the show dated September 20th. Yeah. If you're missing the second half of that broadcast, we're going to upload it again, so you just have to delete the one that's in your podcast in order to go back and get it, and re-download it. Sorry about that. That's the first of that in several hundred episodes.

Anyway, we're talking about *The Illusion of Needs* and our fundamental goodness. Saying that, "Lack does not exist in the creation of God, it is very apparent in what you have made."

What we do in this world is all thought produces form at some level. That's the teaching of *A Course in Miracles*, "All thought produces form at some level."

What is form? Form is everything we see. It is our experience. It is our emotions. It is also our thought. Thought creates more thought. Thought creates our emotions. Thought creates our physical form. Thought creates all of our experience and our world, situations and circumstance of our life are created for our thought. The illusions of needs that's created by our thought as well.

In this world of form, our thoughts, we can create when we're in tuned with the mind of God, and whatever we create is perfect. It's expressions of perfection and Beauty and Truth and Wisdom and Clarity and Freedom, and all the wonderful spiritual qualities of God. What we make comes our interpretations, our interpretations of lack, attack, limitation and separation.

We can give our mind over to perfection and live without needs or we can keep interpreting everything, making the meaning of things and live in lack, attack, limitation, separation. This is our freewill choice.

Now we're back to *The Illusion of Needs* here in Chapter 1, Section VI, Paragraph 1.

"Lack implies that you would be better off in a state somehow different from the one you are in."

Just think of any place in your life or many places in your life where you are experiencing lack. Just contemplate that for one moment. Yeah. It could be in your relationship. It could be in your health, your wealth, your creativity.

"Lack implies that you would be better off in a state somehow different from the one you are in."

When is the appearance of lack in our life? It's because we are not in alignment with Truth. Abundance, remember when it said in the previous paragraph, "*The Abundance of Christ is the natural result of choosing to follow him.*"

Think of—one of my favorite teachings, "Seek first the kingdom, which is within, and all else will be added unto you." All else is added unto us because it's already been given. This is what *A Course in Miracles* says to us. Ask and it is given because it already has been given. We've already been

given perfect Love, perfect creativity, perfect Abundance, perfect Prosperity, perfect Wholeness, perfect Wisdom, perfect Clarity, all the spiritual qualities of God, perfection already given to us. This is our fundamental goodness, the spiritual qualities of God, are live streaming all the time. *A Course in Miracles* also calls them the Great Rays. This is our true nature.

When we're willing to see it in ourselves, see it in our brothers and sisters, then that's all we'll see.

"I am Fundamentally Good"

Our natural state is perfection and Wholeness and Freedom and Joy and Wisdom and Clarity, Harmony and Beauty, Abundance and Prosperity, all spiritual qualities of God that are full on 100% clean and pure. When we start believing in impurity, when we start believing in degradation, then it seems as though the purity gets degraded. The Wholeness gets degraded. It gets limited. But it's only our belief in imperfection showing up as the appearance in our life. But in Truth, we're perfect, whole and complete. But we don't believe it.

Like if you just start working with an affirmation such as, "I am perfect, whole and complete, " probably it's going to trigger in your mind what you do believe, which is a belief in lack and limitation. Just say that yourself three times gently and sweetly, "I am perfect, whole and complete. I am perfect, whole and complete. I am perfect, whole and complete."

Yes. Now, what's get triggered in your mind? Does the thought get triggered in your mind? No, I'm not so great. That's not true. Look at my life, it's a mess. When we say this affirmation, what happens sometimes is we get triggered into recognizing what we really believe. Then the ego mind will start affirming what we really believe. Remember, all beliefs are false and Truth is true eternally. That's why it's an illusion of needs.

I was teaching about this when I was in Cairns, Australia, and I was saying, "Here's the affirmation to begin working with and it's, 'I am fundamentally good.'" We started with just working with that, "I am fundamentally good. I am fundamentally good." People were triggered into what were their beliefs. The beliefs "No, I am bad. I'm unworthy. There's

something wrong with me. I'm not good enough." Bringing that to the light. I am fundamentally good. If it triggers a false belief, then take that false belief, offer it to the Holy Spirit for healing.

What was so beautiful was, the next day we came back for another workshop, and there's a beautiful woman, Ella, in our group and she had that morning on the way to the workshop, she had encountered a number of people. She encountered some people who seemed to be irritated or unhappy or disturbed in some way. She conveyed this affirmation to them and said, "Just think on this for a moment, I am fundamentally good, " and she asked them how it felt. She saw each one of them shift when they work with that affirmation, "I am fundamentally good, " that they began to brighten, that they could agree with it.

Now, often times in a workshop when I can see the people and they're right in front of me and ask them, "Do you have a sense that you're fundamentally not good, that there's something wrong with you, that you're bad?" Many, many, many spiritual students have a belief that they keep hidden, that they don't want anyone to know, and this was definitely me, that they are fundamentally bad, that there's a deep evilness or wrongness in them. I get it because I used to have that, too. For me it came from this experience that I had all the time of anger, resentment, wanting to attack, and feeling like I wanted to murder someone, feeling like I just wanted to burn the house down, feeling like I just wanted to go into a rage and a rampage.

When I would have that experience of this extreme rage and anger boiling up, that feeling would be so intense that I equated it with something evil inside me. Evil, evil, evil, some darkness. I was afraid of it. I was afraid that I was going to somehow allow it, like a monster to be unleashed. There were times when I wanted to unleash it and it frightened me, so I kept it hidden, thinking, "I can't let them see who I really am."

For so long, I was identified with this one who just wanted to burn the house down, wanted to kill everybody, go ballistic, go impulsive. I felt that was the real me that I had to keep hidden. But now, just working with that thought, "I am fundamentally good."

I encourage you to work with that affirmation and allow whatever you believe hidden, seen, unseen, felt, not felt, recognized, unrecognized. Allow it to come to the surface. "I am fundamentally good." Whatever comes to

the surface that seems to oppose, "I am fundamentally good," allow to be given to the Holy Spirit for healing. Make an offering of it. Allow it to be offered up. Just give it away.

Holy Spirit, please take this thought out of my mind, so I never think it again. I am fundamentally good. This is the only thought that I need. I am interested only in discovering my fundamental goodness. I'm interested only in knowing the Truth about my life. I am so grateful and so thankful that my true nature is fundamental goodness.

Taking that breath. I am fundamentally good. It is my true essence and my true nature. You see, and if we're willing to believe this, the Abundance of Christ is the natural result of choosing to follow Him, Him being the Holy Spirit. Just resting in that.

Recognizing the Unity of Life

It says here in *The Illusion of Needs*, Paragraph 1.

"Lack implies that you would be better off in a state somehow different from the one you are in."

Our natural state is our true reality where everything is perfect, whole and complete, including us. Lack implies that we believe we're better off in a state of separation, and that's why we've chosen it. Why would we choose separation unless we had a belief that it was better? How do we choose separation? We choose separation through thinking, "better and worse."

A perfect opportunity for us to heal our minds is presidential election. Because isn't it so easy to look at the candidates and think, "better or worse"? Isn't there an incredible invitation to think, "better or worse"? But what if we use this presidential election to heal our mind of better or worse? Because better and worse is the ego's number one tool for separation, that's how the ego gets us into separation thinking, "This one's better. This one's worse." That's the whole genesis of separation in the first place. There is no better or worse if all is one, how can you have better and worse?

That's what true humility is, is recognizing all is one, there can be no better or worse. If you start thinking you're better than or you're less than, you can get back to true humility and Oneness by recognizing it's not even possible to have better or worse, but we can believe in our mind that better or worse exists, but all is One, you can't have better or worse.

We can have preferences, I prefer vanilla. Some people prefer chocolates. I prefer this candidate. Some people prefer the other candidate. But why do we prefer the candidates? Because of the meaning we make of things. All things work together for good, so we're looking to make the most loving choices, being led and guided by the Spirit.

It says here, *"Until the 'separation...'"* and it has separation in quotes because there is no separation. There's only the illusion of separation.

*"Until the 'separation,' which is the meaning of the 'fall...'*fall is in quotes because there's been no fall, just the illusion of a fall, *"...nothing was lacking."*

Until we started thinking thoughts of separation, there was no lack. The end of all lack comes with remembering the Oneness. If you're trying to improve your finances, if you're trying to improve the flow of Abundance and Prosperity in your life, remember your fundamental goodness which is your Christ nature and that you're not separate from the goodness. You're not separate from the Christ. You're not separate from your brothers and sisters. It's remembering the Unity of all life that brings the true flow of Prosperity and Abundance. Why not activate the true flow of Prosperity and Abundance in your life instead of just manifesting some more stuff?

Because I could have bought an adaptor, I could've said, "Well, I don't trust that Spirit is going to provide me for an adaptor, so I'm going to buy one." Those adaptors, you can spend a lot of money on adaptors, especially at the airport. You can spend \$10, \$15, \$40 depending on what kind of an adaptor you buy. This is how we get into experiencing lack and limitation.

The friend that I'm staying with right now, a couple of years ago, I had a desire to get a dehydrator. I want to make banana chips and kale chips and dehydrate food and have fun playing with food like that. I thought, "I'm going to get a dehydrator for my birthday." I started shopping online for a dehydrator. The Spirit said, "No, don't buy one now. Just wait." I thought, "Well, I don't really wish to wait. I really like to have one now." I got the strong intuition. "Yes, but wait." I was obedient. I satisfied the ego's need to show up for one by—just identifying which one I would buy if I were going to buy one.

A little bit later, my friend said, I'm staying with right now, I was at their house, they said, "Hey, we bought this dehydrator model, but we realized this is not the one we want. We were going to send it back. Would you like to have it? We'll give it to you if you'd like to have it." It was \$100 worth of

equipment. I said, "Yes. I would like to have that. Thank you very much. I'll put that in my car right now."

I could've said to Spirit, "No, I don't want to wait. I want to buy one." I would've bought one and gotten it and started to use it. But a week later, one of my friends gave me a dehydrator. That's how Spirit works. We can be in tuned.

You see, recognizing the Unity of all life that is our source of Abundance and Prosperity, because all blessings flow from God. Where else could they flow from? You see, when we are in our mind thinking that someone is better than and someone is worse than, we are worse than, we are not good enough, we are not fundamentally good, then therein lies the belief in lack.

Living in the Abundance of Christ

Going back to the *Wholeness and Spirit*, Paragraph 5, "*Whatever is true is eternal, and cannot change or be changed. Spirit is therefore unalterable because it is already perfect, but the mind can elect what it chooses to serve.*"

Spirit is already perfect. But we can decide, are we going to serve two masters, try to choose two masters to serve? Or are we going to live in the Abundance of Christ? The Abundance of Christ is the natural result of choosing to follow the Holy Spirit, to live by Spirit.

Jesus says, "The miracle is a sign that the mind has chosen to be led by me in Christ's service."

In *The Illusion of Needs*, it says, "*There were no needs at all,*" until we chose thoughts of separation.

It says, "*Needs arise only when you deprive yourself. You act according to the particular order of needs you establish. This, in turn, depends on your perception of what you are.*"

A sense of separation from God is the only lack you really need correct.

The real purpose of this world is to use it to correct your unbelief. You can never control the effects of fear yourself, because you made fear, and you believe in what you made. In attitude, then, though not in content, you resemble your Creator, Who has perfect faith in His creations because He created them."

God has perfect faith in us because He created us.

"Belief produces the acceptance of existence. That is why you can believe what no one else thinks is true. It is true for you because it was made by you."

At the end of the section, it says, *"Perfect Love casts out fear. If fear exists, then there is not perfect Love. But: Only perfect Love exists. If there is fear, it produces a state that does not exist. Believe this and you will be free."*

Believe this. I'm going to say what it is.

"Only God can establish this solution, and this faith is His gift."

I'm inviting you this week to work with this affirmation. "I am fundamentally good. It is my true nature. I am fundamentally good." Whatever that thought produces in your belief system, whatever comes up for healing, whatever contrary thought comes up in your mind, give it to the Holy Spirit for healing.

Alright. Time for me to wrap up. *A Course in Miracles* tells us that forgiveness is the way out of hell. Forgiveness is the end of lack.
