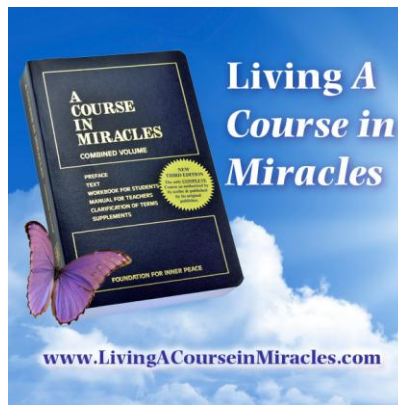

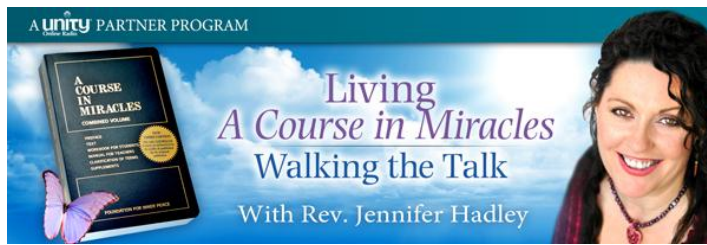


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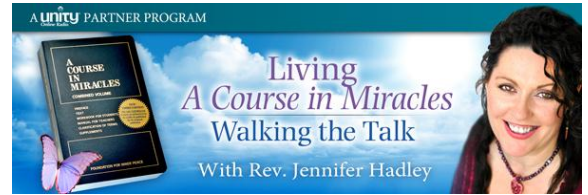

Jennifer Good morning. Good morning. It's definitely morning for me. I'm in Kauai, Hawaii. It's just 5 o'clock in the morning here. The roosters are crowing. The sun is not up yet. Yeah. So grateful to join with you. I'm Jennifer Hadley.

Our topic this week is the *Release of Fear of Failure*. How are we going to do that? Let's see. We'll begin by tuning in and tuning up to the Higher Holy Spirit Self. I invite you to place your hand on your heart, and that's exactly what I'm doing right here right now. Consciously connecting and communing with the Holy Spirit. Prayers are means of communion, communication, and we're interested in that, learning that communication.

We're consciously opening our heart and mind to accept the Atonement for ourselves. We're willing to remember that our true identity is perfect Love and that is the true identity of all our brothers and sisters. We're willing to surrender all belief in spiritual failure. We're willing to surrender fear, doubt, worry, because we're surrendering the causes to the Higher Holy Spirit Self, to our elder brother, teacher, Jesus.

We are grateful and thankful to open our heart and mind to the power and the presence of Love, our true identity. We're grateful and thankful to share the benefits of our healing, awakening, expansion, Clarity with everyone because we're One with them.

In grace and gratitude, we let it be, and so it is. Amen. Amen, Amen, Amen.

Patricia Cota-Robles: A Truth Teacher

Yes. First, before we get in to our topic, I just like to share that we've got the *Living A Course in Miracles* Classes on--those are the free classes. We still got six more free classes. In fact, we have eight because last week's classes, our topic was "Loving Yourself and Loving Others." Our theme for this entire series is "Loving Yourself Free."

Our teacher last week is Patricia Cota-Robles. She is not a Course teacher. Sometimes people question, "Why would you have *A Course in Miracles* teacher participating in *A Course in Miracles* series?" Well, the reason is truth is truth and there aren't different versions of the truths. Truth is truth. Patricia Cota-Robles teaches truth. She truly does. I think that she's a very clear teacher of truth. She studied all the world's religions. She also studied *A Course in Miracles*, although she's not *A Course in Miracles* teacher. She's a truth teacher.

Many people who listen to her class last week have written to tell me how grateful they were. One of the things that we've decided to do with her classes is they're on indefinite replay, so anyone could go and listen to them at any time. Usually the replays are free for 48 hours, but she and I agreed that her classes would be up on replay indefinitely. She did a healing mediation that's free for downloading as well. You can go and get those.

Some people, as I say questioned, some people even send me angry e-mails and think that I've done something wrong and bad by having a non-course teacher teaching in a *Course* series. But let me just say, I spoke to someone yesterday who said, "I'm so grateful that I found you. I don't know how I found you, Jennifer, but I'm now studying the *Course* and I discovered the *Course* because of you."

People find me through this radio show because of the Unity connection, even though Unity is not *A Course in Miracles* teaching, it's a truth teaching. I always am guided by the Holy Spirit to have a couple of teachers, at least

one per series, who are not *Course in Miracles* teacher, but who are truth teachers.

In the series--and what happens is then, literally, a thousand or sometimes several thousand people will come and hear the *Course* teachings and become inspired to begin studying *A Course in Miracles*. I've learned to do what I'm guided to do, even though not everybody likes it, not everybody approves. Some people get really angry with me and some people attack me for it. I've learned to follow my guidance regardless.

For those who might wonder who is Patricia Cota-Robles and why is she in the *Course* series, I encourage you to go and listen and see if you can hear truth in her teachings. There you go. Check it out!

Feeling of Unworthiness

One of the things--and that's directly related. Holy Spirit is telling me now to our topic this week about *Fear of Failure*. One of the things that, for me, really kept me in a place of, you could say failure to launch, was that I felt unworthy. I felt unworthy of my calling as a spiritual teacher. I didn't feel worthy at all to be a spiritual teacher because I thought, "Well, I'm so judgmental, feel ashamed, I feel guilty, I feel wrong and bad, how could I ever, ever be a spiritual teacher, " and yet all I was interested in was God and talking about God and sharing about God. It was just becoming stronger and stronger in me.

But I knew that I wasn't 100% committed, not all in. I was still falling down in my own ability to just be loving every single day. I found that I was falling down in my choice to be loving, so often that I was judging myself a lot.

I'm going to take a sip of my tea here. I got a little something in my throat. I know sometimes people don't like it when I tell them I'm going to take a sip of my tea. And then, other people tell me, "Oh, I love it when you sip your tea. I sipped my tea, too."

That's one of the things I've learned, is if I'm trying to please everyone, it doesn't work, so my guidance is to follow the Holy Spirit's guidance. And then I can succeed. But if I'm trying to please everybody and make everybody happy, well--you know when I'm identified with the ego, you can't really make me happy for more than a second. So, I'd rather that

anyone in my life help me to remember the truth, rather than to help me satisfy the ego which is unsatisfiable. It can feel like a quandary sometimes. So, I felt unworthy of my calling.

But you know what? One of the things--I think Michael Beckwith said so eloquently is that, "God does not call those who are already qualified. God qualifies those who are called. And all are called, all are chosen." We're all the chosen. No one is left out. It's not possible. We're all one. How could anybody be left out? So, we're all called and we're all chosen.

Calling to be Teacher of God

What *A Course in Miracles* tell us is that if you're a teacher of God, your students will find you when you decide to learn. Even before I found *A Course in Miracles*, that's what I decided to do, to learn. I was willing to learn. I was so happy with anyone, who would join with me, to learn because that helped me. I knew it helped me so much.

I started my first *Course in Miracles* group on the phone, because I was tired of driving. I had been doing so much driving living in Los Angeles. I started on the phone also because there were people that I had connected to through work that I was doing all over the world, who are so hungry to talk about spiritual teachings and I connected with so many people by phone who didn't have a spiritual community, or even a spiritual friend anywhere near them. They just had this longing to be able to connect in the Spirit and to be able to even hear somebody else share about their understanding of God, their experience of God, and to join together. I surely understood that longing. Oh, my gosh! I sure did.

I don't know if I ever shared this on the radio show, but I share it in class sometimes. Some of my spiritual friends in Los Angeles that I knew love to talk about God as much as me. Sometimes they'd invite me to a barbecue or party or something and I'd say, "Would it be okay if I came early and we could talk about God for an hour before everybody else arrived?" I mean I really used to do that. I just--all God all the time. I just really had this hunger and thirst to, and I still do, to know God and talk about God all the time which is now my profession.

What I realized in my journey of not feeling adequate, not feeling worthy of my calling, "Who am I to talk about God? I'm still judging people. I'm still angry. I'm still resentful. I still have all these upsets and feelings of upset,

inadequacy. How could I ever be worthy of a calling to be a teacher of God?”

Well, I decided to have compassion and love myself and forgive myself. I also decided not to hide how I felt. I decided not to hide the fact that I felt unqualified. And to simply say, "I'm starting a study group. I'm starting a book group. I started different things. I'm going to share what I'm learning. I'm not saying I'm an expert, I'm just sharing what I'm learning." People started to join with me and in my study group, which was on the phone, and you can get maybe hundred hours of those recordings for free at iTunes and the podcast is called *Masterful Living thru A Course in Miracles*. I think it's T-H-R-U. *Masterful Living thru A Course in Miracles*. Maybe hundred hours of those study groups.

I just did what I was called to do. Sometimes one person would show up. I realized and discovered that many more people were listening on the free download. Many people have told me over the years that those recordings are valuable to them.

Willingness to Learn God's Words

The biggest thing is in our fear of failure is that we actually believe we can fail. What I have learned is there's learning that we're able to do if we're willing. If we're willing, if we have that little bit of willingness, then we can learn. Learning is really remembering our true identity. We're learning to remember that we are Love. We're learning to value Love and being loving, making loving choices.

The teacher is really one who's willing to learn and that's all that's required is that little bit of willingness to learn. And then the guidance will be given, the teachings will be given and will be led. Yes, we may fail to be loving many, many times a day, but we'll begin to succeed more and more.

If in any endeavor, like let's say your endeavor is to sell cars, or to sell solar paneling, or to just raise your children well to love themselves. If your goal is to find a friend and have a good friend, if your goal is to find a romantic partner that you can have a holy relationship with, if your goal is to pay off your debt, if your goal is anything in this world and you simply give it to the Holy Spirit and say, "Make it holy. Teach me how to achieve the one goal of accepting the Atonement for myself as I walk on this journey." Let this goal of building a house, or writing a book, or any goal that you might

have, let it be filled with the Holy Spirit's purpose, then we cannot fail. It will become a learning device for us and our mind will open. The Holy Spirit will use anything that we give.

In Chapter 4, Section 6 of the text--Chapter 4 is the "Illusions of the Ego," and Section 6 is "The Rewards of God."

It says, "How can you teach someone the value of something he has deliberately thrown away?"

We have thrown away the value of simply being loving. If we're willing to value that, it's like pulling the thread on the sweater and the Holy Spirit will lead us and guide us all the way home.

Picking Oneself Up from a Failure

We're back talking about eliminating Releasing Fear of Failure.

What I've learned is that God cannot fail as me. If I'm aligned with God and my purpose is to accept the Atonement for myself, to remember that I am perfect Love and so is everyone else, to remember that I am One with God and so is everyone else. I'm One with my brothers and sisters. When I am willing to see the innocence in myself and in my brothers and sisters, and to use everything that is in my experience to help me to remember that, then I cannot fail.

However, what I've also learned again and again and again, if I am giving what seems like Love or compassion or kindness, in order to get something, then I am failing in sharing and extending Love. I'm giving to get which means I'm aligned with the ego, which means I'm coming from a sense of lack and limitation. So when I'm giving at my job, that if I'm giving in my family, if I'm giving in my friendships in the workplace, if I'm giving anything in order to get something in return, I'm affirming that there is lack, I'm affirming that there is limitation, and by affirming that, I have to experience more of it.

People have a fear of failure and taking risks. Why? Because they're trying to get something, they've basically made whatever it is they're trying to get or wanting or thinking that they need. They've made that a false idol. When we worship the false idol, then we will experience some kind of failure because we're coming from a place of lack and limitation.

What I realized was Jesus was telling us the truth when He said, *"If I be lifted up, I draw all unto me."* That's what I realized for me to do is I am interested in being a teacher of truth, and I'm only interested in teaching the truth. I'm not interested in anything else, truly.

As my profession, of course, I become interested in lunch or going to the beach or something like that. But in everything, I'm truly interested in that, waking up in that Atonement. As long as I'm choosing that in each and every moment, then I cannot fail. The Holy Spirit won't let me fail. But if I think that my goal is something in the world and that becomes the focus of my goal, not waking up while I'm doing something in the world, then I've already failed.

Setting Goals Accordingly Through God

It's so valuable to learn that. That's what I realized, oh, my gosh, as long my motivation is waking up, accepting the Atonement for myself, attaining enlightenment, the end of belief and separation, remembering my true identity, however you would like to name it, as long as that is my one goal to forgive myself for having idolized separation and separation thinking. As long as my goal is to join with the Holy Spirit and listen to that One Voice, allow Jesus to be my teacher, the Holy Spirit to be my guide, as long as I'm doing that, I cannot fail. But if my goal is to make money, if my goal is to have some effect in the world, then I'm already failing.

I have a goal today to complete this radio show, but it's not the goal for my life and it's not the reason I'm doing the radio show. I'm doing the radio show, so that I connect with the Holy Spirit and can share that connection that we can use technology to transcend time and space and to join together because I know that joining together is what strengthens our awareness of the One Mind, the One power, the One Presence.

Throw Your Miseries Away

Going back to Chapter 4, Section 6, "The Rewards of God," Paragraph 5.

"How can you teach someone the value of something he has deliberately thrown away?"

We deliberately threw away our awareness of the Oneness and Unity of all life. We threw that away deliberately.

Jesus says, *"He must have thrown it away because you did not value it."*

We didn't value it, instead we valued the meaning that we made of things and we valued our attack thoughts and our belief in separation.

He says, *"You can only show him how miserable he is without it, and slowly bring it nearer, so he can learn how his misery lessens as he approaches it."*

The thing we're not valuing is the Oneness.

He says, *"You can only show someone how miserable they are without the oneness and slowly bring it nearer, so he can learn how his misery lessens as he approaches it."*

This is what's happening for us, right? We're slowly approaching the remembrance of our true identity and as we practice being loving, compassionate, extending the light that we are, our misery lessens. But if we're trying to that, if your goal in being a spiritual teacher, is to get validation, to feel better about yourself, if your goal is to get money, to get approval, to get anything, then you will fail in some way. Even though you might become successful in the world, you'll fail in your heart because your motivation was not one that would help you heal your mind. It's one that strengthens the ego in your mind. The only way that you can truly succeed in God is to fail in the world. Isn't that what we experience all the time?

This is what it says in the Trust Section in the *Manual for Teachers* that as we go through our life experience, we're going to have all kinds of

experiences of loss, and that loss helps us to learn what is truly valuable. As we learn that the things of this world are not truly valuable, only Love is real, only Love is valuable, only our waking up is valuable, then we discover that everything in our human experience is helpful to us in that journey of remembering and awakening.

It says here that our experience of the misery lessening as we approach our remembrance of the truth, it says,

"This teaches him to associate his misery with its absence..." with the absence of oneness in our mind, Love in our heart.

"...and the opposite of misery with its presence."

This is what we're learning every day that when we choose Love, we feel better about ourselves. We feel more like our true selves. When we choose to worship false idols, then we are more miserable. All suffering is caused by having attachments to--trying to make this world different or better or to get something in this world.

If our trajectory is we're trying to get something, we're giving our gifts and talents to get something, then we're not sharing Love, we're not extending Love. It's a different path that we're on and it is a path that's going to lead us to suffering because it is that suffering that's going to push us to choose again and choose again, because we're going to be--when we're suffering, we're going to choose again, because we know that it ain't, kid. That's not it. That's causing suffering. This is why sometimes people kill themselves is because they keep choosing things that aren't working. Love is the way out of everything. Love is the healer of every cause of illness in this world, because there is only one cause of any kind of illness. Whether it's mental, emotional, physical, seeming spiritual illness, all discord and disharmony is that one choice to energize separation, and to value something that is not truly valuable.

When we're willing to value that which is truly valuable, even a little bit. Like me, myself, I still get distracted by things of the world. This is a global ministry that I'm running now. With thousands of people, many thousands of people participating, and so it can be distracting at times. That's where my work is, that's where my real work is, not to be distracted by, "Oh, is there a problem with the website? Oh, is there a situation with--. The e-mail didn't go out, " this or that. And not to be also distracted by people who are angry and upset because the website isn't working or something like that.

To always go back to, “Holy Spirit lead me, guide me, what am I to do this day?”

Recognizing and Acknowledging Miseries

Jesus says here, *“It gradually becomes desirable...”*

So, choosing one that's in Love.

“Gradually becomes desirable as he changes his mind about its worth. I am teaching you to associate misery with the ego and Joy with the Spirit. You have taught yourself the opposite.”

We have taught ourselves to associate misery with the Spirit and Joy with the ego, the pleasures of the body and feeling good about ourselves because the ego is feeling good.

I think most of us, as spiritual students, we've been down that road so many times. We're tired of being miserable. We're sick and tired of being sick and tired. I'm telling you, if you would like to prove God, there will be a huge leap in your awareness. Proving God to me is really being willing to place trust and faith in what is unseen in the Love of God leading us and guiding us. Love doesn't need anything. Love is patient. Love is kind. Love does not boast and brag. Love does not need anyone's approval or anyone's recognition or appreciation.

One way to know if you're giving to get is, are you looking to get recognition, are you looking to get something in return? If you're looking to get something, even if it's a, “Thank you, ” even if it's a recognition of your efforts, then you're giving to get. You're aligned with ego. If you can just turn that around by literally saying to Jesus, saying to the Holy Spirit, “I feel this need for recognition, I feel this need for appreciation. I feel this lack in myself, and I feel like a big dark hole that needs to be filled by other people's loving me, other people's recognition, all of that. This darkness, this hole that seems unfillable, I'm giving it to you, Holy Spirit. I am willing to believe that all this misery, this suffering, this thoughts of suicide, that they can be healed if I give them to you. I don't know how to heal them, but I wish that they be healed, and I am willing to be led and guided.”

That's what I did. I started to be led and guided. Then I had so many choices to allow myself to be led and guided or not, to take the guidance or not. Many times I've failed, but I started to succeed more and more.

That's the beautiful of teaching in Lesson 68, my favorite lesson, *Love holds no Grievances*, where it says,

"If you succeed even by even a little, there will never be a question of your motivation again."

So it's that willingness to simply give it a go. I can honestly say if you're willing to consistently choose Love, you won't ever fail. Again, it depends on your goal. If your goal is something of the world, if your goal is to get something, there's going to be a constant stream of failure. But if your goal is to seek the Atonement for yourself, to choose the Atonement for yourself, you have to seek it, just choose it.

You can't fail and then allow yourself to be guided and led through every day and every choice that you make. Jesus says to us here,

"You have taught yourself the opposite. You are still free to choose, but can you really want the rewards of the ego in the presence of the rewards of God?"

My trust in you is greater than yours in me at this moment, but it will not always be that way. Your mission is very simple. You are asked to live so as to demonstrate that you are not an ego, and I do not choose God's channels wrongly. The Holy One shares my trust, and accepts my Atonement decisions because my will is never out of accord with His. I have said before that I am in charge of the Atonement. This is only because I completed my part in it as a man, and can now complete it through others. My chosen channels cannot fail, because I will lend them my strength as long as theirs is wanting.

I will go with you to the Holy One, and through my perception He can bridge the little gap. Your gratitude to your brother is the only gift I want."

Let us be grateful and thankful right now that we can make this choice and we don't need any special skills, we don't need any equipment, just your willingness.

Give Service to Your Brothers and Sisters

We're back. I'm Jennifer Hadley. We're talking about the Release of Fear of Failure.

So many spiritual students have reached out to me and said, "I'd like to have a career in spirituality and being a spiritual counselor, spiritual teacher. I'd like to do what you're doing, Jennifer. I'd like to start study group, but I'm afraid," or people would say, "I've studied Reiki. I've studied this. I've studied that, but I don't know how to make a living at it."

What I can tell you is giving it all to the Holy Spirit and say, "It is my desire to wake up to be of service in this world." Being of service is the greatest way to live. Being of service to our brothers and sisters is being of service to our selves. However, if--again, we're doing it in order to get anything.

Let's say you're volunteering. If you're volunteering in your church community, if you're volunteering anywhere in order to get some kind of validation in order to feel better about yourself, then your motivation really is one of lack.

Wouldn't it make sense that if your motivation is to get something in the world or from the world that it would be best for your learning that you would fail? Does that makes sense? If you're trying to get some kind of validation, even if you're trying to earn a living, and you think that you have to do this or that to earn a living. If you're validating this world, idolizing this world, trying to get something from this world, rather than to be the Love of God, to express something in this world, to share something in this world, because the only thing worth sharing are the gifts of God which are eternal.

So the gifts of God, the great race if you will shining forth are Love and Peace, Harmony, Freedom, wholeness, Abundance, Clarity, Purity, Creativity, Wisdom. All the spiritual qualities of God are real, eternal, and we can express them. Our expressing them helps us to remember who we really are. We are the spiritual qualities of God. Our creations to use the word that is used in the *A Course of Miracles*, our creations of Love and

perfection, and wholeness, and Freedom, and Joy, and Wisdom, and Clarity, and Purity, all are expressions, our creations of these spiritual qualities are eternal and infinite in their nature because that is God's nature, that is our nature. When our dedication is that expressions.

First of all, the fear falls away. There's no sense of lack and limitation anymore. There is a deep and abiding sense of Abundance. One thing is people fear Divine Guidance, they fear that they're not receiving it. They fear that they are not able to receive it. They fear that they're going to make ego choices, but they really are fearing making the most loving choices, the God choices. Because the God choices will lead us away from valuing the things of this world.

Think of it this way, this is what just came to me in my mind. If you have a strong belief that you would be a better person or your life would be better if your body was different, so you're focused on making your body different, or you're focused on thinking that your body is not good the way it is, that is bad or wrong and should be changed, that in any way, it should be altered or should be different. You're pursuing that. The Higher Holy Spirit Self is giving you the guidance. Just let it be. Instead, just love the body temple, just love it as a vehicle, just love it! Love every self-vibrant function of your body as it is. Don't try to change it.

Seek not to change the world, but to change your mind about the world. Seek not to change your body, but to change your mind about your body. The ego will say, "That's insane. I can't be happy until I'm healthy. I can't feel free until I'm healthy. I can't feel free or happy, or lovable, until my body looks a certain way or it can never look that way. So I can never feel beloved."

The idea of giving up those thoughts which cause so much pain is actually frightening. We keep perpetuating the sense of suffering, loss, lack and limitation because literally it is the recognition that we already have everything and nothing on this world matters. That is more frightening to us than the, than the fear of failure in the world.

Our work in our heart and mind is to choose the Atonement for ourselves. Jesus tells us over and over again that we will be led. We will be guided if we're willing and to trust Him. So, we have to trust first. We must trust first.

Choosing the Direction Towards God

In Chapter 8, "The Journey Back" Section 1. It says in Paragraph 4,

"Your past learning must have taught you the wrong things, simply because it has not made you happy. On this basis alone, its value should be questioned. If learning aims at change, and that is always its purpose, are you satisfied with the changes your learning has brought you? Dissatisfaction with learning outcomes is a sign of learning failure, since it means that you did not get what you wanted.

The curriculum of the Atonement is the opposite of the curriculum you've established for yourself, but so is its outcome. If the outcome of your curriculum has made you unhappy, and you want a different one, a change in the curriculum is obviously necessary. The first change to be introduced is a change in direction. A meaningful curriculum cannot be inconsistent. If it is planned by two teachers, each believing in diametrically opposed ideas, it cannot be integrated. If it is carried out by these two teachers simultaneously, each one merely interferes with the other. This leads to fluctuation, but not to change. The volatile have no direction."

And isn't this what we've all done? One minute, the egos are teacher. The next minute, the Spirits are our teacher. Going left, right, left, right, fear, Love, fear, Love, fear, Love. And another fact is we always feel off-balanced, oscillating back and forth, not making any real traction, because we're not willing to choose a direction and go in one direction. This is the curriculum in *A Course in Miracles* is to get us to see the value of going in one direction, letting the Holy Spirit and Jesus be the shepherd out in front of us leading the flock.

Did you know that a flock where the shepherd is out in front is the healthier flock in the world of form? And that when the shepherd's behind, pushing, cajoling, prodding, the flock itself is not as healthy. I think that's interesting.

We've got our teacher out in front of us leading us and guiding us. We cannot fail if we put the Holy Spirit in-charge. But we're not going to succeed in getting what we want, because getting what we want just affirms more luck and more limitation. Give up the wanting, recognize the Kingdom's installed. We already have it. We don't have to give to get. We can just share and extend Love, and then we'll be successful every minute of every day, because even when we fail, we can choose again.

Closing Prayer
